### Kindergarten Registration

Registrations are currently being accepted in the office during regular office hours. After June 12<sup>th</sup>, registrations may be taken to the District Office, 3783 Forni Rd. The following information will be needed to register your child:

- 1) Your child's original BIRTH CERTIFICATE. Your child must be five years of age by 12/2/08 in order to register for the 2008/09 school year.
- 2) IMMUNIZATION RECORD – initialed/stamped by the physician's office supplying the appropriate dates for each required immunization.
- 3) PROOF OF RESIDENCY in the Mother Lode School District (i.e. utility bill, rental agreement, escrow papers, etc.)
- 4) HEALTH EXAMINATION – In addition to the above requirements, a health examination done NO EARLIER than February 15<sup>th</sup> and recorded on the State approved form PM171A.

5) ORAL EXAMINATION – Proof of an oral health assessment performed by a licensed dental health professional.

**Your child will not be assigned a teacher and placed in a class until you have obtained the health examination and all shots are current.**

### BOARD VACANCY

Mrs. Rebecca Giles, a valued and respected member of our Board of Trustees since September 2005 has moved out of our District and, therefore, can no longer serve on the Board of the Mother Lode Union School District. The Board of Trustees accepted Mrs. Giles' resignation at its regularly scheduled meeting held on May 14, 2008. The Board of Trustees has determined that this vacancy shall be filled by appointment. To be eligible for consideration, the person must be an adult citizen who resides in the Mother Lode Union School District. The term of the appointment shall be until November 2008 (the next regularly scheduled election for district Board members).

Contents of the personal letter of application should include the person's vital statistics, reasons for desiring to serve on the Board of Trustees, current or previous participation on committees and/or Boards, community services performed, and a statement regarding the applicant's philosophy of education. A professional resume should be included with the letter of application.

Letters of application and resumes are to be received in the District Office by 4:00 p.m. on June 6, 2008.
